An On-line assessment in a multiple choice or True/False format that can be accessed direct from your computer. It will provide topic specific questions which can be answered by an on-line click. At the end of each assessment the result is shown. Importantly, the questions are randomly shuffled by the software so that they are selected and presented in random order and the correct answers to multiple choice questions are also shuffled to encourage participants to learn the correct answer.



In addition, past CBFCA exams are loaded on the site for access and discussion as are our Mock Exams compiled for participants to attempt and compare answers with those placed on the site for discussion

The aim is to provide all the information broken up into individual topics so that all related material appears under the one link and can be accessed by all registered participants at any time during the period of the course.

Finally, David takes a “hands-on” approach with his students and is always available for consultation by email and, if necessary, discussions in person, on-line or by phone to solve those difficult issues.
